Offered by.....Roger and Marguerite Mansfield**

A walnut plaque with engraved plate offered by Roger and Marguerite Mansfield through the Pembroke Welsh Corgi Club of Southern California, Inc., for competition at its specialty shows only. For permanent possession, this award must be won three times by the same owner, not necessarily with the same dog. Should there be less than 2 bitches in competition, the trophy will be retained by the Trophy Chairman.

Four-to-Six Month (Beginner Puppy) Competition Regulations

Classifications - The Four-to-Six Month Puppy competition shall be for dogs that are four months of age and over but under six months on the day of the event. Classes will be offered for breeds and varieties and divided into Groups as described in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows* and the Miscellaneous Class breeds as listed in Chapter 3, Section 23. The Miscellaneous class competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show. The FSS competition will be the equivalent of Group competition and the winner will be eligible to compete in Best Four-to-Six Month Puppy in Show.

Entry and Eligibility - Entry and eligibility requirements include: The Four-to-Six Month Puppy event may be offered at licensed or member dog shows at the option of the show giving club. ¶ Four-to-Six Month Puppy Competition must be listed in the premium list, entry form and judging schedule, if offered.

¶ AKC registration number or an AKC litter number will be required for entries of an AKC recognized breed as listed in Chapter 3, Section 1 of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.

¶ A foreign born dog may enter this class if they are registered in the country of origin.

¶ FSS number or FSS registered litter number will be required for Miscellaneous and FSS breed entries.

¶ All entrants are to be vaccinated (including rabies) in accordance with their veterinarian's protocol.

¶ Professional handlers are not permitted to exhibit in this class. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

Titles - The Certificate of Merit (CM) title is an introductory title to AKC conformation events. Entrants in each breed shall compete for Best of Breed and Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed. Winners of the Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their breed or variety. Winners of Best of Opposite Sex to Best of Breed in each of the individual breeds or varieties will be awarded points toward the CM title based on the number of dogs defeated in their sex. Group winners will be eligible for the highest number of points earned by any breed within that Group. Best Four-to-Six Puppy in Show will be eligible for the highest number of points earned by any breed entered.

The Certificate of Merit requires 15 points awarded in accordance with the following points structure.

Dogs Competing Points ¶ 2 - 1 ¶ 4 - 2 ¶ 8 - 3 ¶ 12 - 4 ¶ 16 - 5

Best of Breed Competition

The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a championship but whose championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90 day period, the championship of a dog has not been confirmed by AKC, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed competition are to be made until its championship has been confirmed by AKC.

Grand Champion Select

When quality warrants, after BOB and BOS are awarded, a Select Dog (SD) and Select Bitch (SB) may be chosen from the remaining Champions (Non Regular Class winners that are Champions and Qualify for BOB are eligible) - (WD or WB are not eligible) (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 3, Section 14 Effective 5-12-10)

Awards of Merit

The Judge of the Best of Breed competition may at her discretion award a maximum of Three (3) Awards of Merit.

Amateur Owner Handler

For dogs that are at least six months of age that are not champions. Dogs must be handled in the class by the registered owner of the dog and is limited to exhibitors who have not, at any point in time, been a professional handler, AKC approved conformation judge, or employed as an assistant to a professional handler. Additionally, members of the immediate family or household of a current professional handler are ineligible for this class (as defined in Chapter 11, Section 13). *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay.*

Best Bred - By Exhibitor and BBE Eligibility

All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. Family members must be both a breeder and owner of record to exhibit in the class. Any entry in the Bred-by-Exhibitor classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Bred-by-Exhibitor. Only the dog or bitch not defeated in Bred-by-Exhibitor are eligible for the Best Bred-by-Exhibitor competition.

Best Puppy

Any entry in the puppy classes that is awarded Best of Breed or Best of Winners would automatically be Best Puppy. Only dogs not defeated in a puppy class are eligible for Best Puppy competition.

Non - Regular Classes Involving Single Dog Entries

Veteran Dogs (For Dogs 7 Years but under 10 years) **Veteran Bitches** (For Bitches 7 years but under 10 years)

Veteran Dogs (For Dogs 10 Years of Age or older) **Veteran Bitches** (For Bitches 10 years of age or older)

Neutered Dogs and Spayed Bitches may compete in the Veterans Classes only at independent specialties and by virtue of winning the class may compete for Best of Breed. (AKC Dog Show Rules, Chapter 14, Section 8.)

Non - Regular Classes Involving Multiple Dog Entries

NOTE: As the judges' decision in the Stud Dog/Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class. **Stud Dog Class** – For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with two of their Get. Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a Regular Class, Best of Breed Competition or some other Non-Regular Class. **Brood Bitch Class** – Same as Stud Dog Class except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get. As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch Classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

REFUND FOR BITCHES IN SEASON

Females in season are not permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition because it came into season and the event secretary is notified no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the club is required to refund the entry fee.
The club will retain a \$4.00 processing fee for the cancellation of an entry.

Sweepstakes Rules

Sweepstakes is open to all Pembroke Welsh Corgis 6 months of age and under 18 months of age who have NOT earned the title of Champion of Record. All entries for Sweepstakes must be entered in one or more of the Regular Classes and entry must be made at the same time, on the same entry blank that the Regular Class entries are made by indicating "Sweepstakes" in the space provided for additional classes; giving the age division and including the additional fee as listed on the official AKC Entry Form. Sweepstakes will be judged before the regular breed classes.

CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1. No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration. See <http://akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change
